GENERAL RULES

NMLRA Rules will govern all matches, except for the General Rules that follow:

1. Absolutely no open powder or open powder containers on your shooting bench at any time.
2. An “Old Timer” is any person who is 60 years of age or older.
3. A “Novice Shooter” is any person enjoying their first year of competitive muzzleloading shooting.
4. All Aggregate Match Targets are to be purchased at the same time that the aggregate is entered. Matches A, B & C are aggregates.
5. No offhand and rest targets are to be posted on the same target frame at the same time.
6. Targets carried over to the next day must be signed by the Range Officer prior to posting.
7. Targets are to be turned in to the target shack for scoring immediately after they are removed from the target frame.
8. A shield or guard must be positioned next to the vent on all flintlocks to prevent injury to the adjacent shooter.
9. Black powder charges only in 45 – 70 and BPCR matches.
10. Cast lead bullets only in the BPCR/45 – 70 Military matches.
11. NYS Open Hunters Matches (47 & 48): Any muzzle loading projectile and any sights legal in NYS during muzzle loading deer season. In-lines and scopes may be used. No spotters allowed on the buffalo target.
12. Entry and reentry fees for Junior & Sub-Junior matches are waived. However, entrants must pay the registration fee. Sub-Juniors must be under 14 and Juniors must be under 18.
13. Single shot BPCR matches are generally governed by NRA rules.
14. Spotters may be attached to target faces for all regular matches EXCEPT # 40, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46 & 47.
15. Practice targets will be allowed dependent upon range space availability. Also, notify the Range Officer if your position will be vacant.
16. The CHALLENGE PERIOD is open until one hour after range closing or until the awards presentation for scores not posted.
17. Relays will be 30 minutes in length. Targets do not have to be completed in a single relay (International matches excluded).
18. Only a single buffalo target may be posted on a frame at a time. No simultaneous sighting targets or spotters are permitted.
19. “Either” for bullet means either lead bullet or round ball.
20. “Any” position includes Bench Rest, X-stick, Prone, or Prone with X-stick.
21. Match 45 & 46: Squirrel Rifle – 10 lbs or less, .40 caliber or smaller.
22. Match #17 (200 yd Rest) allows either bullet or ball.
23. Match #49: Novelty Gong match. \$2 entry/re-entry. Highest score of 5 shots wins; tie-breakers posted.
24. Match #36 & 37: BPCR with antique-style scope.
25. Match #50: Hawk/Knife Throw. Scoring details posted in the registration shack..
26. Match #51: Paper cartridge Breech Loader Rest match.
27. CAUTION: Under NYS regulations, individuals without a NYS Pistol Permit may not shoot pistols or revolvers in matches.

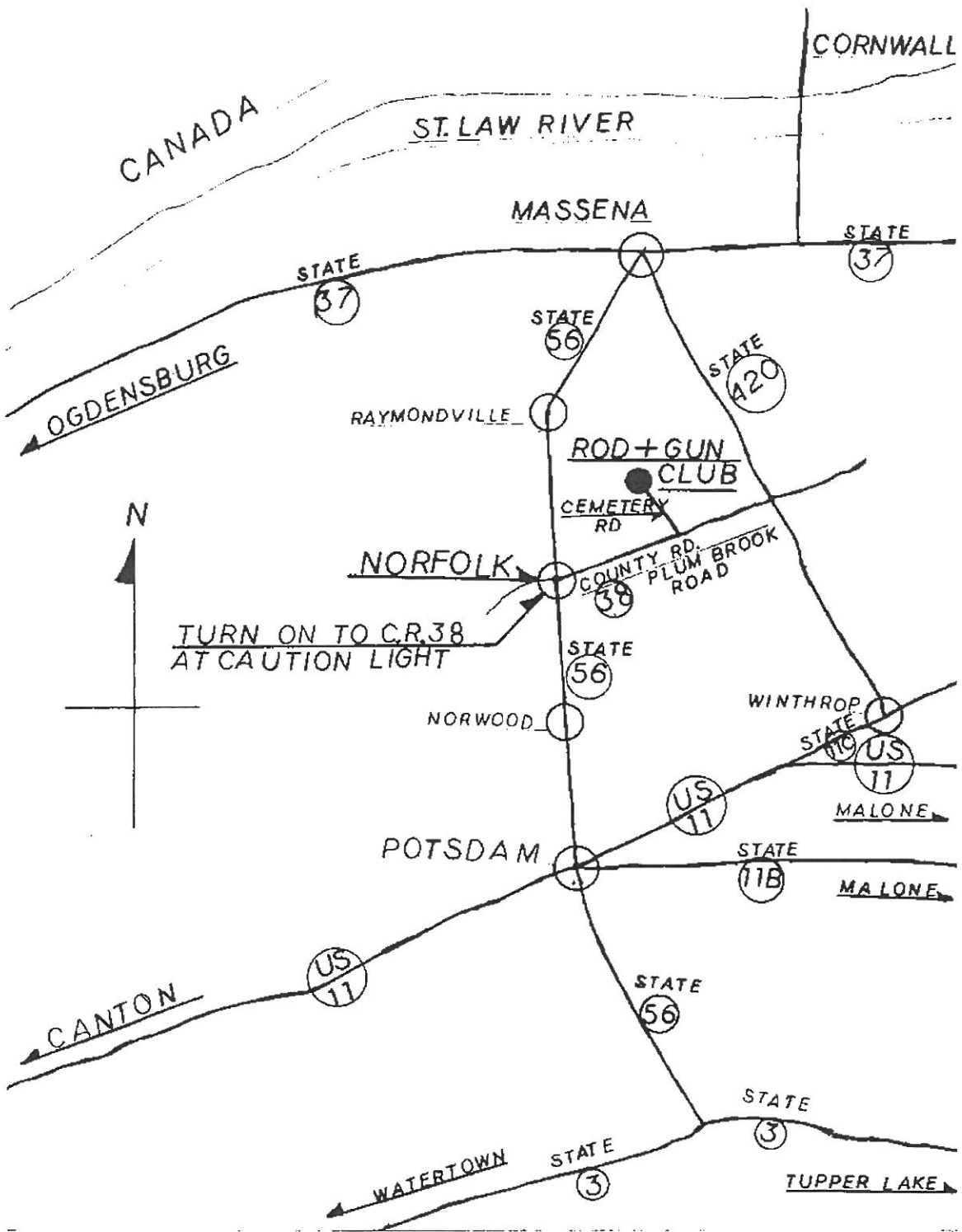
