

St. Lawrence Long Rifles Club & Range Rules

- 1 Shooters at SLLR events are encouraged to be current-year paid members.
- 2 Always keep firearms pointed in a safe direction. Do not load, cap, or prime until at the firing line and pointed downrange. Never fire into or over the tree line.
- 3 Loading benches must be behind the firing line. Never shoot over a loading bench.
- 4 Use only black powder or approved substitutes. Measure powder separately—never load directly from a container. No smokeless powder or duplex loads allowed.
- 5 No open powder containers on the firing line or loading bench.
- 6 Ammunition must be patched round ball unless otherwise specified. Sabots allowed only in designated matches; no plastic wads or shot sleeves.
- 7 Flintlock matches require a safety shield at the vent.
- 8 Go downrange only after a cease fire is called and all firearms are made safe. Do not handle firearms while anyone is downrange.
- 9 Use safe targets only. No glass, rocks, or structural supports. Clean up your area after shooting.
- 10 Do not dig into berms without Range Officer permission; restore any disturbed area.
- 11 No alcohol on the firing line. Anyone consuming alcohol may not return to shoot that day. No one under the influence may be on the range.
- 12 No smoking on the firing line during shooting hours.
- 13 Shooters under 18 must be supervised by a parent/guardian or have written permission filed.
- 14 Parents are responsible for children. No unsupervised children on or near firing or tomahawk ranges.
- 15 The Range Officer may remove anyone acting unsafely or using unsafe equipment.
